The suffix is always **@uni-freiburg.de**

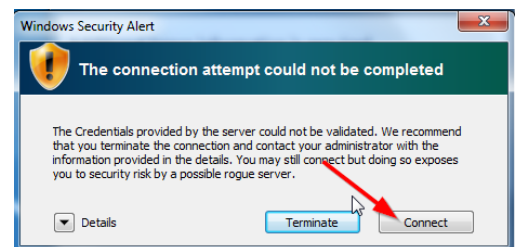
The Password is your RAS Password. Set or change it in myaccount if you have not already done this.
